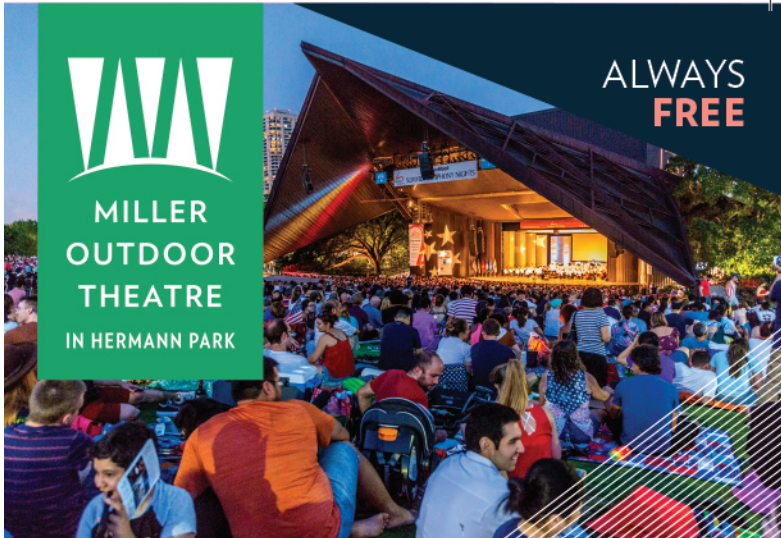

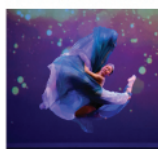

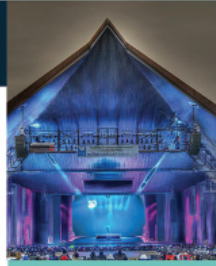

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1 Grab a spot on the hill or reserve a ticketed seat** the day before the show on our website. Either way the shows are always Free! You can always score a ticket for a seated spot at our box office up to an hour before the show, while availability lasts.
- 2 Bring a picnic**, for the hill or the auditorium. Just remember, no glass containers, no smoking, and no pets please. And if you can't bring your own, you can always stop by concessions for some snacks and wine!
- 3 Families are welcome!** Miller offers a welcoming environment that makes it easier for wiggly kids to enjoy.
- 4** There are **easily accessible wheelchair spaces** in the covered seating area. For information on these and other seating accommodations, call 832-487-7123 in advance.
- 5** Remember! When facing the stage, left side of the hill is reserved for **lawn chairs**, and **blankets** may spread out on the right. Following these guidelines helps make the experience enjoyable for everyone!
- 6** Be sure to **plan ahead for parking and walking**. Ticketed seats are freed up 5 minutes after the curtain speech.
- 7** At Miller Outdoor, **the show goes on rain or shine!** Be sure to check our social media pages to stay up to date on any news.
- 8** Movie nights and mid-week youth performances are not ticketed.
- 9** Can't make it to the show? **We livestream select performances** throughout the season! Visit our website for more information.
- 10 Take a chance on something new!** Our season has something for everyone, so it's easy to catch shows that suit your specific interests. Consider checking out a show, group, genre, or style you've not seen before. No matter the performance, we guarantee you'll feel the Miller Magic watching a show under the stars.

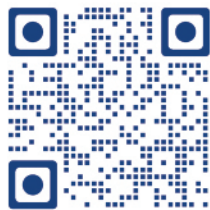

Why worry about parking and traffic when you can ride METRORail to Miller Outdoor Theatre with ease? It's fast, direct, and convenient. Taking the rail is easy. Simply park your vehicle at METRO's Fannin South Park & Ride Lot (Fannin at West Bellfort) or one of the other public parking lots along Main Street and hop on the METRORail. To get to Miller Outdoor Theatre using METRORail, exit at the Hermann Park/Rice U Station or the Museum District Station, and you're just a short walk away from top-of-the-line entertainment.
